## Wrinkles, Ripples or Humps & Bumps?

Here are some of the main reasons. And it's not just poor installation.

- Installation was originally done with a **Knee Kicker**
- Heavy furniture pulled dragged across the carpet.
- Heavy traffic in one main traffic areas (With padded carpets)
- Water damage
- Chemical spills
- Over use of cleaning solutions.

But by far your instincts are right, the problem is usually installation related. But not just any poor installation, but what I call seasonal installation concerns. Here's what I mean.

The time of the year makes a huge difference. If you have this problem most likely you got your carpet installed in either **late fall** or late Spring. Why does that mean anything? It's because when carpets are **COOL** they are very restrictive and harder to handle with a Knee Kicker.

In some ways that makes it easier for the techs to cut and install the carpet, but what happens next is deceptive, the carpet is either kicked in or (sometimes) power stretched it in and it looks great.

**But ...**(you knew that was coming)

Because it looks great people never question whether the job was done right.

At first what was described is a typical installation. That would be Ok, if it was in a warm time of the year, because as mentioned the Carpet that was installed in the cool months will began to acclimate to room temperature once it does, it will relax and this is the beginning of your problem and it ages, it becomes more flexible, the carpet should have been allowed to acclimate to room temperature or a power stretcher should have been used. Because it wasn't the results begins to show itself.

If the installer tried to kick in a cool carpet he was not able to stretch the cool carpet and get rid of the excess carpet. Which is why you have the ripples and buckles.

This is why in about a year-in-a-half to 3 years, you suddenly notice the carpet starting to buckle. It starts small and then seems to pop up all over the place depending on the room.

Here's what should have been done.

They should have cut the carpet to room size

Then allow it to set for one day with the temperature above 72 degrees then come back the next day and power stretched it in.

Another reason why guys kick it in, is because kickers are 10-12x less expensive than a power stretcher. Power stretchers are \$700-\$900 so they send a bunch of guys out and you end up (depending on the time of the year) with a hit or miss as to whether you will get wrinkle, ripples or humps and bumps in your carpets.

So now what.

### **But Andre My Dog Ate A Hole In My Carpet, Can You Fix That?**
